CO2 Detectors - Gift that could save a life!



Carbon monoxide, a poisonous gas created by gas stoves, furnaces, and hot water heaters, is the number one source of accidental poisoning within our homes. At higher levels it is deadly, but because it is colorless and odorless, at lower levels it may go undetected for long periods of time causing flu - like symptoms in an unsuspecting person. All new homes and apartments are required by law to have a CO2 detector close to each bedroom. Available at most store for around \$25.00, it is a small price to pay to protect you and your family. Consider a carbon monoxide detector for your home.

Recycling– Important Reminder!

The recycling center is open Wednesday and Saturdays 8:30am– 5pm. We accept glass, plastic, newspaper, cardboard, steel and aluminum cans. *Please break down all cardboard and place it in the outside dumpster.*



As a reminder, these items are NOT accepted:

- *No styrofoam and packaging material
- *No plastic bags
- *No plastic filled with motor oil or antifreeze
- *No canning jars, window glass, ceramics, dishes or drinking glasses
- *No scrap metal

Household recyclables make up over 50% of Minnesota’s household garbage. Recycling that material instead of sending it to the landfill can reduce waste and save energy. Go Green!

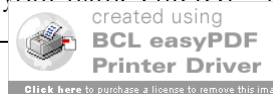
